A few historical details: Until 1953, most Indigenous peoples in Bolivia were subjected to a life of indentured servitude. It was against the law to teach Indigenous Bolivians to read or write. In the 1920s, an ecumenical group owned a large farm in the village of Huatajata (on Lake Titicaca) which was home to 275 serfs (slaves). In the 1930s, this project was turned over to Canadian Baptist Missions. A CBM missionary (Merrick) argued that

slavery was a conspiracy against the gospel and must end.

The action taken then was the liberation of the Amara working on the mission farm and the title for the land being turned over to them..
