- I. The Gentiles and the demons
 - A. I Corinthians 8:4-6
 - B. Who were these so-called gods? I Corinthians 10:20
 - C. Paul is presenting to the Gentiles that there is also are nefarious spiritual forces at work to drag us into slavery again.

II. KNOW your enemy!

Sun Tzu - It is said that if you know your enemies and know yourself, you will not be imperiled in a hundred battles; if you do not know your enemies but do know yourself, you will win one and lose one; if you do not know your enemies nor yourself, you will be imperiled in every single battle.

- A. Admit you have one
 - I Peter 5:8 Be watchful Satan is seeking to devour
 - James 4:7 I John 4:3 Eph 6:12
- B. Realize he has plans for YOU!

Eph. 6:11 II Cor 2:11 Luke 22:31,32

- Satan has demanded all of us (plural "You")
- He wants to sift your faith!
- God is sovereign!
- Jesus is praying for each one of YOU (singular "You")
 Romans 8:34
- C. We must fight him in the Power of God that is freely provided to us

Eph. 6:10 II Cor 10:4

- Clothed in armor
- In consistent relationship with Him
